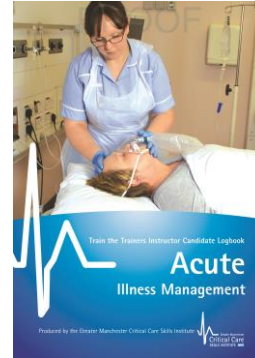


AIM© TRAIN THE TRAINERS



This is a one-day course held at the Critical Care Skills Institute to train and support potential faculty to deliver the Acute Illness Management (AIM©) course. It is suitable for those who are new to delivering the course and is generic for Adult AIM, Clinical Support Worker AIM, Maternal AIM, and Paediatric AIM courses. To access Train the Trainers your organisation needs to be an AIM licence-holder. You will need to have attended an AIM course beforehand and have gained an understanding of its format. Nominations for the course are to be put forward by the local AIM Lead/AIM Champion who will have identified you as "Instructor Potential".

Content of the course

- Outline of AIM course
- Overview of teaching and learning
- How to deliver a workshop
- How to facilitate scenarios
- How to facilitate testing/assessments

All Train the Trainer candidates will be given a logbook, with a requirement to teach on a further two AIM courses

A certificate of competence will be issued on completion of the logbook

To maintain instructor status you need to teach on a minimum of two AIM courses per year (these can be Adult, CSW, Maternal or Paediatric courses)
