Process for booking onto AIM Train the Trainers (AIM TTT)

Potential candidate identified by local AIM Lead/Champion as Instructor Potential for AIM TTT Instructor Potential form to be completed, signed and sent to Critical Care Skills Institute

Critical Care Skills Institute will acknowledge receipt of the request and check availability of preferred date(s), offering alternatives if dates have been fully booked in the meantime

Purchase order to be raised, if not already done so, to University of Manchester Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, and sent by email to Critical Care Skills Institute AIM.CCSI@mft.nhs.uk

On receipt of Purchase Order:

- Critical Care Skills Institute will confirm the booking
- An invoice will be raised on the NHS Foundation Trust system
- Pre-course paperwork will be sent to candidates approximately 2 weeks prior to attendance

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Important – Purchase Order should be made out to the NHS Foundation Trust, <u>not Manchester</u>
University

Purchase Order <u>must</u> be sent to Critical Care Skills Institute email address, <u>AIM.CCSI@mft.nhs.uk</u>, otherwise it may not be received Critical Care Skills Institute will hold places provisionally for a maximum of 2 weeks pending receipt of Purchase Order

Non-attendance

Candidates have 3 opportunities to attend the course within a 12 month period of their first booking, after which they are deemed not reliable or not ready to enrol with the teaching faculty

If a candidate is on their first or second booking and advises their AIM Lead that they are unable to take up their AIM TTT place at all (eg moving into a new post; long-term sickness), the second and third opportunities are transferable to another member of staff as long as they attend within 12 months of the original booking

After 3 opportunities / 12 months the place is forfeited and there will be no reimbursement of the cost
